PREPARATION FOR ULTRASOUND

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Please understand that there is one ultrasound sonographer in our office. Due to the limited time that she has if you are 15 minutes late or more you may be asked to reschedule. Thank you for your understanding.

Obstetrical

In order to visualize the uterus and ovaries it is necessary that your bladder be full. We ask that you drink at least 3 to 4 large glasses of fluid, preferably water about 1 hour prior to your examination. Patients over 21 weeks along only need to drink half of the recommended amount of fluid. If you do not like water, you may drink anything but milk. Do not urinate until your examination is over. The procedure will take about 20 to 30 minutes. We limit this visit to two people in addition to you. Thank you for your cooperation.

Pelvic

The pelvic ultrasound is performed vaginally and does not require a full bladder.
